IT IS THE APPLICANT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE ALL SIGNS ARE TAKEN DOWN PRIOR TO POLLING DAY

Sign requirements:

- All free standing signs must be erected to the specifications outlined on the attached guideline.
- Signs should not be a physical hazard or erected in a manner as to cause obstruction to traffic or the general public.
- Signs must not incorporate flashing illumination or retro-reflective material.
- No signs should be erected on road reserves, median strips or similar locations, including Council property e.g. lamp posts, trees etc.
- Overstreet banners for electioneering purposes are not permitted.
- Signs on property adjacent to a state highway should comply with the New Zealand Transport Agency guidelines.
- Signs are not to be erected on state highway land without written approval of the New Zealand Transport Agency.
- Signs are not to be erected on private property without permission of the property owner.
- Section 221B (2) of the Electoral Act 1993 specifies that electoral displayed in a public place or on private property can be up to 3m² in size.

It is the applicant's responsibility to see that the provisions of the Electoral Act 1993 are complied with in every respect.
