4.1 Hearing of Submissions on the Long Term Plan 2024-2034 and Simultaneous Consultation

1. Reason for Report

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to provide details for the oral submissions that will be heard by Council at the meeting on 18 April 2024.

2. Context

- 2.1 The consultation document *Where's it @ Rangitikei* for the Long Term Plan 2024-34 was adopted for public consultation on 29 February 2024. Consultation commenced on Friday 8 March 2024. Submissions closed at 5pm on Sunday 7 April 2024.
- 2.2 Council consulted simultaneously on the:
 - Draft Revenue and Financing Policy
 - Proposed Schedule of Fees and Charges 2024/25
 - Draft Rates Remission Policy
 - Draft Significance and Engagement Policy
 - Draft Development Contributions Policy
- 2.3 To speak at the hearing, a written submission is required to be provided to Council indicating that the submitter would like to speak at the oral hearing.
- 2.4 As of 12 April 2024, 23 submitters have been scheduled to speak at the oral hearing.
- 2.5 The hearing timetable is attached (Attachment 1). The written submissions related to the oral hearing are provided under separate cover.
- 2.6 The collated written submissions of those speaking at the oral hearing are provided under separate cover.

3. Financial Implications

- 3.1 There are no financial implications associated with the oral hearing. Any financial implications associated with topics raised at the oral hearing will be considered as part of the Deliberations meeting scheduled for 16 May 2024.
