Covid-19 hit our expected player numbers and audience very close to the event, where we had more than 15 people drop out from our player list. We were able to get some additional adults to assist so the event could go ahead.

What worked really well: *

The level of skills shown by the players, and the learnings from the tutors. The standard of playing at the end was impressive, particularly given how short a time they had to rehearse. Due to the change in format, we were able to give some of our young players the opportunity to work with a professional musician as a soloist, and we were able to record that performance.

What didn't work so well/could be improved? *

Our promotional campaign was hindered by uncertainties regarding Covid-19, which was still very present in the community's mind and homes. Key staff also dropped out without notice, giving those left a larger workload around their normal lives. Our supporting tutor had to be replaced, requiring a change of program. We did not go to the market as aggressively as we should.

All in all, the 2023 event made us realise we needed more people with specialist skills to ensure the Gumboots Band would continue. Since then, we have consulted with our target market, who have identified issues with timing of the event and our 2024 event is well on the way to success due in part to the learnings of this project.

Most of the events went ahead as planned. It was very disappointing for the dancers to have to relocate for a second year in a row. We are working on a plan to provide a dancing stage that will be safe to use if there is rain.

The light rain in the morning did not hinder any of the other events and the weather improved to a fine day.

The field events are becoming very popular with all ages and the assistance provided by the Queen Alexandra regiment from Linton is a great help.

This year, a very animated address to the Haggis was performed by Maggie Whittle. The first time a lady has done the address for us, her presentation was extremely entertaining.

What worked really well: *

Everyone worked well together. The decision to move, and the relocation of the dancing to Marton went smoothly. The communication of the move was spread quickly.

This year we had a group of young bagpipers and drummers from a Palmerston North band manage the "Have a Go" area. They bought vibrancy to the area and had a lot of visitors.

What didn't work so well/could be improved? *

Again the effects of inclement weather saw the Highland Dancing relocate away from the Turakina Domain. We are looking at having a covered transportable stage for one group of dancers and will work on a way to provide more weather proofing for the covered area of the second group. The move meant around 100 people moved to Marton. The lack of the
